Software and drivers for your Belkin Wireless USB Hub come preinstalled on your computer. To set up the Hub, follow the instructions below.

A. Double-click the "Wireless USB Manager for Windows Vista" icon found in the Windows system tray at the bottom-right corner of the Windows desktop.



B. Once the Wireless USB Manager opens, click on the "New Connection" button.

Note: You will be asked to select a method of Wireless Security Association. The Belkin Hub currently supports two methods: PIN Association and Cable Association. PIN Association requires you to enter the PIN number found on the bottom of the Hub. Cable Association requires you to physically connect (associate) the Hub to the computer with the enclosed mini-USB cable. Either process will ensure a secure wireless connection for future use. Numeric Compare Association is not applicable.

3. The device setup will recognize your Hub as a "Belkin Wireless USB Hub". Change the device name if needed, for example, "Living Room". You can also change the detection method of the Wireless USB Hub. Click "Finish".



4. Remove the mini-USB cable.

5. Once this process is complete, return to the Wireless USB Manager. You should see an icon for the Belkin Wireless USB Hub. If there are two green arrows pointing to each other, you have successfully connected to the Belkin Wireless USB Hub.



6. You can now plug your USB devices into the Hub and access them wirelessly.
